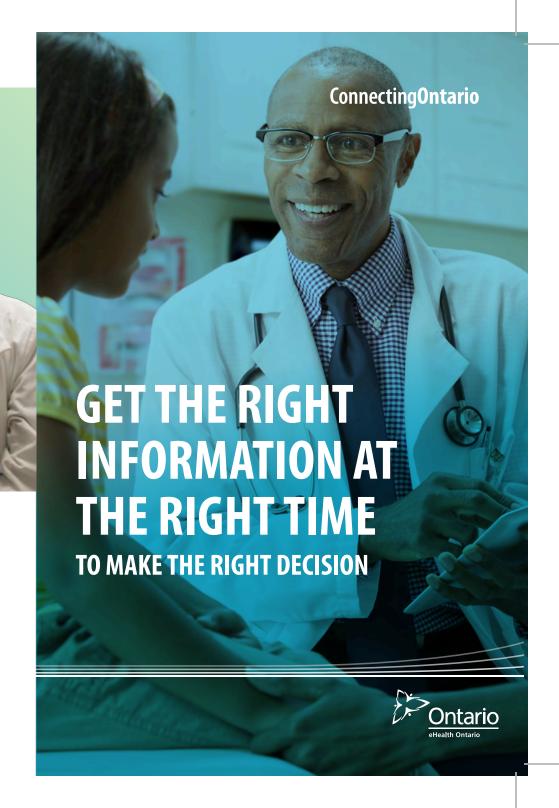

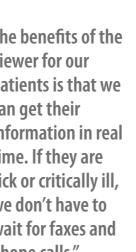

electronic health care systems across the province. Together with the local health integration networks (LHINs) and health service providers, we are delivering integrated electronic health records for Ontarians.

Divided into three regional health information centres that cover central, northern and eastern, and south western Ontario, health care providers across the continuum of care will be able to securely access patients' personal health information electronically.

We take patient privacy seriously

With robust standards and policies, patient rights and their information are protected. Access to patient records is limited to only those clinicians who need to know to provide care. Patients can restrict access to their records and find out who has accessed them.
